About the Visit

High School and Post-Secondary Schools

In my hour-long author visit, I will spend the first 30 minutes introducing myself and explaining how a traumatic life experience determined my path in life. I will show students that my writing when I was young was a direct reflection of the trials that I faced. I will discuss with them about how true authentic writing comes from deep within ourselves. Everyone has his or her own story to tell and each story is genuine and worthwhile. I will then transition into how I started writing poetry and eventually the Dudley Series. I will devote 15 minutes to answering questions and leave 15 minutes to conclude with signing and personalizing books for students who would like to purchase their own copies.

Middle School

In my hour-long author visit, I will spend the first 30 minutes talking about how middle school was probably the challenging years while I was in school. I will discuss how my writing was a release from all the outside pressures. I will share a few experiences of my middle school years that influenced my writing. I will suggest journal writing as a means to deal with all of the "middle school drama" that students must deal with daily. I will devote 15 minutes to answering questions and leave 15 minutes to conclude with signing and personalizing books for students who would like to purchase their own copies.

Elementary

In my hour-long visit, I will spend the first 15 minutes talking about some authors that rhyme. I will then tell them that my books rhyme too. Next, I will talk about friendships and how I still have some of the same friends that I had when I was their age. I will talk about how friendships are important and in my case, I had very special friends. I will talk about being different from everyone and how my friends accepted me just as I was. I will devote 15 minutes to answering questions and leave 15 minutes to conclude with signing and personalizing books for students who would like to purchase their own copies.
